AN EXAMPLE OF A METHOD OF COMPILING INFORMATION

- ▶ THIS TOOL WAS CREATED THROUGH THE NATURAL SUPPORTS PROJECT AT THE WAISMAN CENTER SEVERAL YEARS AGO
- ▶ THE PROJECT TEAM LOOKED AT WEBSITES OF SEVERAL LARGE HIGH SCHOOLS IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF WISCONSIN TO CREATE THE LISTS OF OPTIONS UNDER EACH CATEGORY
- ▶ THE IDEA OF THIS PARTICULAR TOOL WAS THAT A SET OF EDUCATORS COULD USE THE ON-LINE SURVEY TOOL TO DETERMINE WHAT WAS CURRENTLY BEING OFFERED, CONSIDER WHAT MIGHT BE MISSING, AND THINK ABOUT LEVEL OF INVOLVEMENT BY STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES
