- Has your son/daughter had experiences interning, working, or volunteering at one or more local businesses? If so, tell me about those. If not, what types of work experiences do you think he/she might like?
- In what other ways is the school assisting your son/daughter to accomplish goals and move through the transition into adulthood?
- What information has been provided to you and your son/daughter about the adult service system (DVR, ADRC, Family Care, IRIS, County, Providers, Transportation, and Disability Benefits)? Who provided that information and how?
- When and in what ways do you plan to gather additional information about the adult service system and transition planning steps?
- Do you feel that some level of guardianship might be necessary for your son/daughter when he/she turns 18? If so, have you received information about guardianship?
- What additional information would be helpful to you and your son/daughter at this time?
